Rules and Regulations For

- 1. This private Cemetery/Mausoleum is intended for the interment of (Ukrainian) Catholics who are entitled to a Christian burial according to the rules and disciplines of the (Ukrainian) Catholic Church.
- 2. Only a duly authorized (Ukrainian) Catholic priest may officiate a burial.
- 3. <u>No burials will be allowed until all associated fees have been paid in full.</u> Payment of fees is borne by the crypt owner (or family or legal representative).
- 4. Deed will be issued upon full payment. Based on Ohio Department of Commerce, Division of Real Estate and Professional Licensing, when someone purchases a burial plot, grave or crypt, they purchase the <u>right to be buried (interred)</u> not the actual ground or property.
- 5. All sales are final. St. Andrew Cemetery Office will not repurchase plot/crypt. St. Andrew Cemetery & Mausoleum prohibits the resale of plots or crypts for profit through bulletins, advertising or any other means. Refer to Section IV Deeds of rules and regulations document for further details.
- 6. Perpetual (general) care fee will be assessed at they crypt/plot holder's (or family or legal representative) expense. Care is to be understood as to the care and maintenance of plots/crypts necessitated by natural growth and ordinary wear, the cleaning and maintenance of roadways and walks, provided there are sufficient cemetery funds for that purpose. Refer to Section XVII Cemetery/Mausoleum General Care (Perpetual Care) of the rules and regulations document for further details.
- 7. The placement of monuments and markers are a privilege and not a right inherent with the purchase of a burial plot. No monument may be erected without the written permission of the Cemetery Office and until all fees have been paid in full. Size restrictions apply. Refer to Section XVIII Arrangements for Memorials, Monuments & Headstones of the rules and regulations document for further details.
- 8. <u>St. Andrew Ukrainian Catholic Cemetery & Mausoleum is not responsible for damage or destruction to monuments or markers. Repairs (if any) to marker will be the responsibility of the plot holder, family or legal representative.</u>
- 9. The Cemetery Authority reserves the right to remove or dismantle existing memorial markers in order to accommodate a new burial. Approved contractor will reset marker after burial. Landscaped area that was disrupted will not be replaced or repaired by approved contractor.
- 10. Landscaping and planting guidelines exist for each section of the cemetery. Borders, edging stones and flowers are restricted to an 18 inch area in front of headstone only if properly maintained by plot-holders family. Refer to Section VI Instructions to plot/crypt holders & plot/crypt holder's Rights of the rules and regulations document for further details.
- 11. The Cemetery Authority reserves the right at any time to change, amend, alter, repeal, rescind, or add to these rules and regulations, or to adopt any new rule or regulation with respect to said cemetery/mausoleum or anything pertaining thereto. (NOTE: Cemetery is closed January and February and any time during inclement weather. This is a safety precaution for all of our visitors.)
